NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Marshall County Board approves the following amendment to the FY2018 budget, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Marshall County Board that the following budget amendment within the Drug Prevention Fund and the same are hereby ordered.
