MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD MEETING July 11, 2019

The Marshall County Board met in the Marshall County Board Room for the July Board meeting on July 11, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. Chairman Kroeschen called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Chairman Kroeschen Vice-Chairman McGlasson, Stash, Minnick, Johnson, McLaughlin, Balensiefen, Gauwitz, Bakewell, Daykin, and Lindstrom present. Donna was absent.

It was moved by Balensiefen and seconded by Stash to approve the minutes for 6/13/19 as presented. Vote shows all ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent, motion carried.

County Engineer Pat Sloan reported on Zoning. Sloan reported that they had a meeting on June 20th for a hearing on a variance request for a sign on the side of River Valley Coop building that is located on Route 40. It was approved by the Zoning Board. He stated that they will not have a meeting in July.

Sloan reported all is well with recycling. He also mentioned that they will be having a collection event on October 25, 2019 at the Marshall County Highway Department.

Sloan reported on Highway. He stated that a couple of employees are out on medical. He stated that the Yankee Lane paving project will soon be under construction as the bid leadings were held and Advanced Asphalt had the lowest bid of \$1,499,000.00. This was 3% greater than what he had thought as Sloan had estimated it to be \$1,447,000.00, but was less than the Federal agreement of \$1,580,800.00. Sloan also stated that no local funds will be required for this construction project. The local funds have been used for Right of Way acquisitions and will be used for the construction engineering. The construction should start in a month. Sloan stated that Curnyn Construction is working on a bridge replacement on 400E in Saratoga Township. On 1400N east of LaPrairie Road the weight restriction limited of 30,000 pounds have been posted.

#19-52 It was moved by Lindstrom and seconded by McLaughlin to **approve Western Avenue Realignment Project BUILD Transportation Discretionary Grant.** Vote shows: all ayes, 0 nays and 1 absent.

Sloan also stated that the Motor Fuel Tax that we are paying has doubled at the pump will only be a 68% increase to our Motor Fuel Tax.

Hector Gomez form the Health Department was present and introduced Emily Hoscheid who was hired for the accounting position at the Health Department.

Sharon DeWeerth and Vicki Waldschmidt who were previous County Board Members wanted to have the Board request that an additional 30 day extension be granted since the Marshall County Board never received the minutes or transcript from the hearing that was held on June 4, 2019 for Buffalo Run. They also expressed their concerns of these facilities coming into Illinois.

Discussion was held.

Roll call vote shows: 2 yes, 9 no and 1 absent.
