

Request for County Aid for Township Drainage Structure

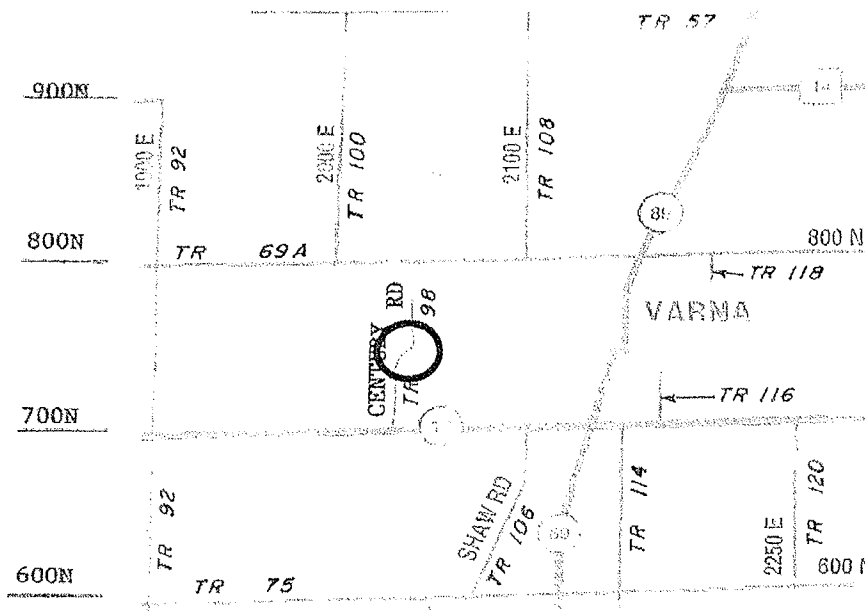

The undersigned Commissioner of Highways of ROBERTS Road District in Marshall County, Illinois, hereby petitions you for aid as provided for in Chapter 605, Section 5/5-501, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, for an appropriation from the County Board Bridge Fund in the County Treasury, a sum sufficient to meet one-half the expense required on the condition that said Road District shall furnish the other one-half of the required amount.

A culvert needs to be **replaced** across or along a watercourse located on Century Road, a Roberts Township road, in Section 29, between 700N and 800N.

The total cost of said work will be approximately \$30,000 , thereby costing the County approximately \$15,000.00



I, Mel Koch, Commissioner of Highways for ROBERTS Road District, further certify that the present structure is inadequate and that the proposed work is necessary, and that the estimated cost of the project is more than 0.02% of the equalized assessed valuation of the Township; and that the tax levy for road purposes in this Road District was, in each of the last two years, not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Chapter 605, Section 5/6-501 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
