

ORDINANCE NUMBER 14-40

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION
IN MARSHALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, public transportation is an essential public purpose for which public funds may be expended under Article 13, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, Marshall County wishes to provide public transportation for its citizens and become eligible for grants from the State of Illinois or any department or agency thereof, from any unit of local government, from the Federal government or any department or agency thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes [30 ILCS 740/2 et. seq.] authorizes a county to provide for public transportation within the geographical limits of the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1. Marshall County shall hereby provide public transportation within the county.

Section 2. The Marshall County Clerk & Recorder shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance within sixty (60) days after passage of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.

Section 4. That the Chairman of the Marshall County Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file on behalf of Marshall County a Grant Application with the Illinois Department of Transportation for the provision of public transportation for the citizens of Marshall and Stark counties.



That the Chairman of the Marshall County Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file on behalf of Marshall County all required Grant Agreements with the Illinois Department of Transportation for the provision of public transportation for the citizens of Marshall and Stark counties.


