

Resolution 14-9

Establishing Stipend for Zoning Board of Appeals Members

Marshall County, Illinois

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Zoning Ordinance, adopted December 11, 2008 and last amended on November 8, 2012, requires the establishment of a Zoning Board of Appeals, Chapter 2, Section 2.2-2; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Board of Appeals members provide a valuable service to the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.2-2A specifies that the Board Members shall be compensated on a per diem basis with a mileage allowance for travel; and

WHEREAS, the amount is to be determined by the County Board; and

WHEREAS, the FY2014 Budget establishes \$3,000 under 075-50019-11 for Zoning Board of Appeals Salaries.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Marshall, Illinois, to establish a per diem stipend to be paid to each member and alternate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the per diem stipend shall be paid for meetings attended and that the stipend includes an allowance for mileage; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Zoning Administration office will file a claim to the County Clerk after each meeting identifying the members present and requesting the stipend payment to each; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the current stipend is \$35 per member per meeting attended.




