Sloan reported on Highway. He stated that there is normal routine and getting ready for construction season. He has been working on negotiations with Auko on the road use agreement for Bennington Wind Farm is continuing. They put a bid in on a one-ton truck that is used. Some scrap was sold.

Sloan reported on Recycling. The next collection day would be April 22nd on Earth Day.

Animal Control: Minnick reported that there is only one dog in the pound.

Building & Grounds: Johnson reported that Vonachens has been hired to clean the Courthouse and that there is a 3-year contract with them but after a year you have the option to opt out. The County will be paying them over \$1900 a month. The boiler had to be cleaned at the Sheriff Department.

EMA: McLaughlin reported that there is a meeting next week.

Finance/Budget: Bakewell reported that the Circuit Clerk Audit is complete, and Hopkins is still working on the Audit for the Courthouse.

County Highway & Recycling: Lindstrom stated that the guard rail that was damaged cost about \$10,000 to replace it.
