Motion:

Recommend approval of ZBA #15-187 Special Use Permit to Ryan Squires for the use of the property at 1014 Willow Road, Sparland, IL 61565 for a recreational use as Squires Mud Bog, with the following conditions, 1) Events for the year will be scheduled by March 1st of every year. If an event is canceled due to rain, it may be rescheduled; 2) Events will be held between May 1st and October 1st; 3) No more than 5 events per year; 4) Events will be held between 10 am and 30 minutes prior to sunset; 5) There will be a maximum of 500 individuals at an event; 6) Traffic will be directed to Route 29 in Sparland; 7) Take steps to minimize mud leaving the property on private and participant vehicles; 8) Willow Road will be cleaned after events; 9) Events will be canceled if it rains more than 2 inches during the Thursday and Friday prior to the event, measured at the Marshall County Airport; 10) Noise will be minimized and any bands or music will stop 30 minutes prior to sunset; 11) Litter will be picked up within 24 hours of an event.

The Marshall County Board approves the #15-187 Special Use Permit to Ryan Squires for the use of the property at 1014 Willow Road, Sparland, IL 61565 for a recreational use as Squires Mud Bog, with the following conditions,

- 10) Noise will be minimized and any bands or music will stop 30 minutes prior to sunset; and
- 11) Litter will be picked up within 24 hours of an event.
