

Request for County Aid for Township Drainage Structure

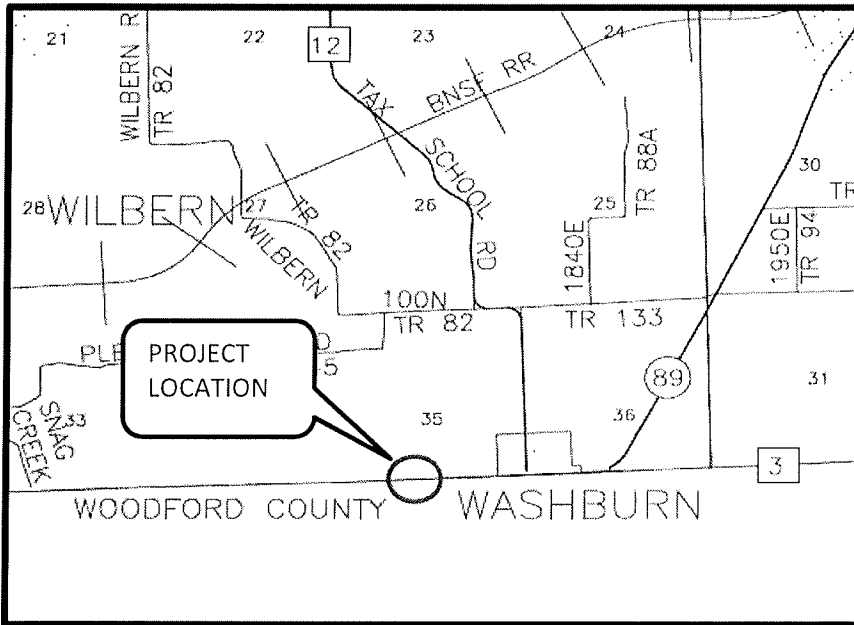

The undersigned Commissioner of Highways of RICHLAND Road District in Marshall County, Illinois, hereby petitions you for aid as provided for in Chapter 605, Section 5/5-501, of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, for an appropriation from the County Board Bridge Fund in the County Treasury, a sum sufficient to meet one-half the expense required on the condition that said Road District shall furnish the other one-half of the required amount.

The work is to repair a bridge as required by IDOT and is currently down-graded to a 3 ton capacity. The bridge crosses Snag Creek on TR 3, County Road 00N.

The total cost of said work will be approximately \$100,000. It is a county line road and a Intergovernmental Agreement will executed with Woodford County. The Woodford County share will be determined by the relative EAV's and is expected to be 70%. The balance will be split between Marshall County and Richland Township, approximately \$15,000 each.



I, Jay Spicer, Commissioner of Highways for RICHLAND Road District, further certify that the present structure is inadequate and that the proposed work is necessary, and that the estimated cost of the project is more than 0.02% of the equalized assessed valuation of the Township; and that they tax levy for road purposes in this Road District was, in each of the last two years, not less than the maximum allowable rate provided for in Chapter 605, Section 5/6-501 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes.
