

ORDINANCE NO. #17-107

**Budget Amendment
County Highway Engineering Revolving Fund**

WHEREAS, the Marshall County Board adopted the annual budget and appropriation ordinance for the fiscal year ending November 30, 2017;

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/6-1003 states, "After the adoption of the county budget, no further appropriations shall be made at any other time during such fiscal year, except as provided in this Division. Transfers from one appropriation of any one fund to another of the same fund, not affecting the total amount appropriated, may be made at any meeting of the board by two-thirds vote of all the members constituting such board, the vote to be taken by ayes and nays and entered on the record of the meeting. By a like vote the board may make appropriations in excess those authorized by the budget in order to meet an immediate emergency.";

WHEREAS, the jurisdiction of a section of road is being transferred between adjoining townships, one being in Marshall County and one being in Putnam County;

WHEREAS, the Highway Department has agreed to pass-through the financial incentives between the townships; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Department has received and deposited in the Engineering Revolving Fund the amount of \$50,628.94.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Marshall County Board hereby deems that pursuant to the provisions set forth in 55 ILCS 5/6-1003, that the fiscal year 2017 Annual Appropriation Ordinance be amended as follows:
