MARSHALL COUNTY BOARD MEETING March 12, 2020

The Marshall County Board met in the Marshall County Board Room for the March Board meeting on March 12, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Vice Chairman McGlasson called the meeting to order. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, roll call shows: Vice-Chairman McGlasson, Donna, McLaughlin, Minnick, Johnson, Balensiefen and Gauwitz present. Chairman Kroeschen, Daykin and Lindstrom were absent.

County Engineer Pat Sloan reported on Zoning. Sloan stated no activity at this time as they did not have a meeting. He stated that there was discussion for two special use applicants, so they may need a public hearing in April.

Sloan reported on Highway. He stated that the MFT letting has been rescheduled for April 2nd at 10:30 A.M. at the Marshall County Highway Department. The reason being they are waiting for approval from the State. The Wenona Road Box Culvert Replacement project is scheduled for bids on March 18th at 10:30 A.M. at the Highway Department. Negotiations continue with Akuo on the road use agreement for Bennington Wind Farm. Sloan stated they are still dealing with snow events. They are putting a new fence up at the Highway Department. Sloan also stated that the fire incident that happened in February at the Highway Department is still under investigation. Insurance is going to pay for them to rent a pressure washer to wash the trucks.

Sloan reported on Recycling. He stated that the next TV collection day would be Friday, April 24th at the Highway Department. He did state that Henry would be having their own collection day for Henry residents in May.
